Treatment Planning with The ASAM Criteria

Person centered, action oriented, and strength-based treatment plans rooted in an ASAM multi-dimensional assessment must replace plans based on program participation and prescribed lengths of stay. A quality treatment plan is a collaborative working document between provider and client. This training will review the tenants of a proper treatment plan, identify common pitfalls, all through case conceptualization.

How to Attend
