

## **New Training Curriculum! Clinical Supervision Training**

The Pennsylvania Department of Drug & Alcohol Programs (DDAP) is pleased to announce the availability of a new Clinical Supervision Training (CST) program, which consists of an online training module through TrainPA and an in-person skills training.

The online CST training will provide a foundation from which clinical supervisors will learn about the basics of clinical supervision, including:

- Regulations that govern supervision;
- Definitions of supervision;
- Developmental theories of counselor and supervisor development;
- Models of supervision;
- Contextual factors/multicultural supervision;
- Legal and ethical issues in supervision;
- Methods of supervision; and
- Supervision across clinical processes

The in-person training will build on the information provided in the online training and provide participants with the opportunity to practice clinical supervision skills. Participants will also be provided with tools to assist in assessing and working with their supervisees.

This training program, both the online module and in-person training, serves as the core curriculum in clinical supervision that is required of clinical supervisors and lead counselors who have not functioned for two years as a supervisor in the provision of clinical services (28 Pa. Code §704.6(c)).

Participants will receive 4 hours of continuing education credit for completing the online training module, and 28.5 hours of continuing education credit for completing the in-person training.

### **How to Access the Online Training**

Visit <https://www.train.org/pa/welcome> then follow these steps (if you already have an account in TrainPA, you may log in and skip to step 7):

1. Click Create an Account
2. Enter a username, password, and the identifying information requested, then click Next Step
3. Select the county where you primarily work, then click Confirm
4. Select "Other public health professional (my functional role isn't listed)", then click Confirm
5. Type "Drug" in the search field, then select PA Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs employees, then click Confirm
6. Click Finish Creating Account. This will log you into the TrainPA site.
7. Click Courses under the Search column on the left side of the page
8. Type "DDAP" into the search bar, then press Enter
9. Select PA-DDAP: Clinical Supervision Training Foundations (Part 1)
10. Click Launch. You will then be able to complete the training.

### **How to register for the In-person Training**

Please download the form and return to our office with a check or money order for the registration fee. Registrations are processed in the order in which they are received, and we must receive both the registration form and fee before a participant will be registered for the event.
